Community Calendar

Melissa Lanzourakis took the lead on this initiative. Melissa and Sarah Fish volunteered to investigate all Community Calendars in the area, engage Antidote 71 to research RSS feeds and see which ones would be most effective to use for Downtown Partners.

Residential and Commercial Engagement

Adrian Kolbo and Ryan Spellman took the lead on this initiative.

The first goal will be to reach out to market rate owners and identify building liaisons that could help communicate information and gather feedback. The other factors in this initiative will be to identify anchor tenants and co-op opportunities while gathering the needs/wants of commercial owners to ensure a consistent message on opportunities and incentives and also allow for easy feedback options.

Lanzourakis and Fish will identify all community calendars to put into a feed for Downtown Partners website and invite Antidote 71.
